In view of the averments made in the applications and in
the interest of justice, the same are allowed, as prayed for.

CRWP No.706 of 2024

1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the
Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus
seeking directions to the official respondents to protect life and liberty
of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents and further to take
appropriate legal action on the representation dated 04.01.2024
(Annexure P-5).

2. At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioners has submitted that they will be satisfied if appropriate

directions are issued to decide the representation (Annexure P-5) within a stipulated timeframe.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Superintendent of Police, Jind to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents.
