This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 20.09.2023 passed in CWP-20862-2022.

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced copy of order speaking order dated 12.02.2024, vide which, the representation of the petitioner has been disposed of. Copy of said order is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.
