1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.398 dated 16.12.2023, registered under Sections 379, 447, 511, 506, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa.
2. Vide order dated 23.01.2024, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the parties had appeared before this Centre. The Mediator has informed the Court that the parties have signed a settlement / compromise deed dated 05.03.2024, before the Mediation Centre.
3. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise deed executed between the parties, before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 23.01.2024, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
