This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 10.10.2023 passed in CWP-22816-2023.

Perusal of the record shows that the order qua which the contempt is alleged, was passed on 10.10.2023. Even the departmental proceedings are shown to have been completed on 10.10.2023 only.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further with the present contempt petition. Hence, the same is dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, qua his un-addressed grievance, if any.
