1. This is an application under Section 151 CPC for placing on record replication to the reply filed by way of affidavit of Sh. Supinder Singh, Joint Director (Admn.), PEDDA.

2. Allowed as prayed for. Replication filed by the petitioner is taken on record.

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3. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 26.08.2022 passed in CWP-18903-2022.

4. Reply by way of affidavit of Supinder Singh, Joint Director (Admn.), Punjab Energy Development Agency (PEDA), filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

5. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 26.08.2022 passed in CWP-18903-2022 has been complied with and the

representation dated 24.05.2022 moved by the petitioner, has been considered.

6. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

7. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

8. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if she feels aggrieved of the order passed by the concerned authority/respondent.
