The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.107 dated 14.07.2022 registered under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 IPC and Section 120-B IPC (added later on) at Police Station Sadar, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Mr. J.S. Sekhon, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed his Vakalatnama. The same is taken on record.
