1. In terms of the interim order passed by this Court on 23.02.2024, an affidavit dated 16.09.2024 was filed on behalf of the respondents in which detailed reasons were given behind the appellant's transfer which included complaints by his wife as also his behaviour towards his colleagues/seniors.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that prior to the appellant's transfer made through order dated 11.11.2022, there was a matrimonial dispute between the appellant and his wife which stands resolved and in the light of such change in circumstance, he be permitted to withdraw the present appeal with liberty to the appellant to make a representation to the respondents seeking therein his transfer back to

Ambala so that he can be reunited with his wife and family.



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3. Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection to the acceptance of the afore alternate prayer made on behalf of the appellant.
4. In the light of the above, we permit to learned counsel for the appellant to withdraw the present appeal with the liberty as prayed for.
5. It is clarified that while granting the afore liberty we have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the request that the appellant may make to the respondents through his representation, if any and consequentially we leave it to the respondents to consider the representation, if any, which may be made by the appellant and decide the same on its merits, as per applicable Rules/instructions. The needful be done within one month from the date of receipt of the representation, if any.
6. All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
