MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to grant the extraordinary concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, a prayer for withdrawal of the instant petition has been made. However, learned counsel submits that the petitioner is ready to appear and surrender before the trial Court within three days and on his doing so, he will move a petition for regular bail and therefore, the Court below may be directed to decide the said petition expeditiously.
2. Dismissed as withdrawn.
3. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for regular bail before the trial Court, the same shall be decided by the trial Court expeditiously in accordance with law.
