1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to take immediate action against respondent No.4, who is harassing the petitioners by misusing his official capacity, with further direction to respondent No.4 to issue prior notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. to the petitioners in case they are required to appear before any police authority.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that husband of petitioner No.1 has been involved in FIR No.148 dated 27.11.2023 registered under Section 304 IPC and Section 21 (1) and 21 (2) of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development) Act, 1957 registered at Police Station Sri Hargobindpur.

3. Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who appears on advance notice, on instructions from SI Ravel Singh submits that the petitioners are not

required at this stage, however, husband of petitioner No.1 is absconding and apart from the FIR supra, there are three more cases pending against him. The investigating officer is performing his statutory duty and there is nothing on record, which warrants interference by this Court in the present case.

4. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and in view of the submissions made by the learned State counsel, this Court find no merit in the present case, which warrants issuance of directions as prayed for by the petitioners.

5. Consequently, the instant petition stands dismissed.
