This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India, read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 31.10.2023 passed in CWP-18481-2017.

Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 31.10.2023 passed in CWP-18481-2017 has been complied with by the respondent qua his part. However, the department concerned, which is to offer appointment to the petitioner, has not been impleaded as a party in the contempt petition.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the matter.

Dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other remedy, but in accordance with law.
