As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representatives of the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹5,00,000/- (₹ Five Lakh Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Learned counsel for the appellants states that appellant No.1, who is widow of the deceased, has since expired and however, appellant No.2 is the only surviving legal heir of the deceased and that the enhanced amount be disbursed to him. Statement of learned counsel for the appellants has also been recorded separately to this effect.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹5,00,000/- in the name of appellant No.2 - Hemant son of Shri Rajbir with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 22.02.2024, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to

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learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
