1. Called twice.
2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner did not come forward to press this revision petition.
3. A perusal of the paperbook shows that the petitioner filed a suit before the Special Court constituted under the Electricity Act, 2003, which was dismissed as not maintainable.
4. Hon'ble Supreme Court in North Delhi Power Limited Vs. Devinder Singh and another, Civil Appeal No.20842 of 2017, decided on 04.12.2017, has held that civil suit before the Special Court constituted under the Electricity Act, 2003 is not maintainable because it is constituted for hearing criminal cases.
5. Hence, the revision petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
