This revision petition has been filed by the plaintiff to challenge the correctness of the judgment passed by the trial Court while dismissing the plaintiff's suit filed under Section 6 of the Specific Relief Act, 1963. he filed the suit claiming forcible dispossession at the hands of the respondent.

2. On 22.12.2023, the following order was passed:-
