Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, and the Station House Officer, Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur (respondents No. 2 and 3 respectively) for taking action on DDR No. 36, dated 03.01.2024 under Sections 323, 326, 354, 354-A, 379 and 452 of the IPC read with Section 34 thereof and Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, which was registered as a cross-version in FIR No. 245, dated 11.10.2021, under Sections 452, 379, 323 and 506 of the IPC read with Section 34 thereof, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Shamsheer Singh, has informed that the investigating officer is taking action on the basis of DDR No. 36 dated 03.01.2024 against respondent Nos. 4, 5 and 6.

Respondent No.4 has joined the investigation. Arrest of respondent No.6 has been stayed vide order dated 20.02.2024 in another petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. of this Court and efforts are being made to arrest respondent No.5 and he is absconding. As per the information, he is residing in Australia.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
