Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.3 to 5 to take strict action against respondent No.6 for running an illegal flour mill and commercial R.O. Water Purifying Plant in the residential area.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that he has instructions to withdraw the present petition.

Learned State counsel, however, contends that he has instructions to file the reply.

Be that as it may, while the petitioners do not intend to pursue the present petition for want of instructions, the petition is disposed of as withdrawn.

However, as the issue pertains to illegal operation of flour mill and a commercial R.O. Plant in the residential area, the Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka (Punjab), shall ensure as to whether any commercial activity is being run illegally or not and in the event of report coming to a conclusion that the same is in violation, an appropriate action shall be taken by the official respondents and a compliance report be filed within a period of 12 weeks.

Copy of this order be also sent to the Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka, for necessary compliance.
