1. The present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for quashing the order No.10183 dated 08.09.2023 issued by the Registrar (Colleges) Punjabi University, Patiala-respondent No.5.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.5 submits that the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed as the College has been permitted to make the appointments, a copy of the order in this regard has produced and also handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner, who submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous, however, in the said order, the expression of appointments as Guest faculty has been mentioned instead of regular basis, for which the advertisement has been issued.
