Prayer made in the present petition is for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to provide the one time password to the petitioners to enable them to open the portal of the website “ Meri Fasal Mera Byora” Yojna.

A short reply by way of affidavit of Pushpender Kumar, Sub Divisional Agriculture Officer, Cheeka, Department of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare, Haryana has been filed today in Court. A copy thereof has been handed over to the counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners. It is averred in the aforesaid short reply as under:

“It is submitted that the present petitioner mobile numbers have been registered on the government portal i.e. MFMB, the petitioners got the one-time password (OTP) on their mobile

numbers for selling their crops through the government portal and the petitioners has been registered their crops on the portal of Meri Fasal Mera Byora.

By referring to the above, counsel for the respondent-State contends that since the mobile number of the petitioner has been registered on the government portal i.e. “Meri Fasal Mera Byora” Yojna, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioner pleads no instructions in this regard. However, taking into consideration the specific stand of the respondents and the short reply having been filed by way of an affidavit, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present writ petition in the event the aforesaid averment is found to be incorrect.
