1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct impartial investigation in case FIR No.0232 dated 20.09.2022 registered under Sections 323/324/325/506/148/149 IPC at Police Station Division No.8, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.
2. On an advance notice, Mr. I.P.S. Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, stated that in the present case, three accused, namely, Nisha, Sonia and Melo were arrested by the police and have been ordered to be released on bail by the competent court. He has further submitted that the final report shall be presented before the competent court within a period of four weeks from today.
3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed in the case in hand and accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
