1. Prayer in this petition is for quashing clause 11 of advertisement dated 06.09.2022 (Annexure P3).

2. It is brought to our notice by learned senior counsel for respondent No. 3 that petitioner earlier filed CWP-20768-2023 with identical prayer but said writ petition was dismissed on 04.10.2023, in view of decision dated 28.09.2023 in CWP-18378-2023 titled 'Malwinder Singh and others versus Punjab Public Service Commission and others'. There is, however, no mention of earlier writ petition filed by petitioner in the instant petition.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner while conceding that earlier writ petition filed by petitioner does not find mention in the writ petition submits that in the index of this writ petition, CWP-20768-2023 is mentioned as identical

case. He goes on to submit that petitioner, after dismissal of CWP-20768-2023

on 04.10.2023, had examined answer sheets and come across number of irregularities, which led to filing of present writ petition.

4. Be that as it may, in our considered opinion, it was the duty of petitioner to include a narration, at least a mention about earlier writ petition filed by her. Same is admittedly conspicuous by its absence. Stating CWP-20768-2023 to be an identical case with learned counsel for petitioner submitting the matter to be different as fresh grounds have been raised, clearly does not come to aid of the petitioner.

5. Faced with the same, learned counsel for petitioner seeks to withdraw this writ petition.

6. Writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn.
