1. On 24.01.2024, the following order was passed:-

“ The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to reissue her passport.

Mr. H.P.S. Ishar, Advocate inter alia contends that petitioner is a minor and she was born in UAE. The petitioner was issued passport on 18.10.2018 which was valid upto 17.10.2023. The petitioner is staying in India with her aunt and parents of the petitioner have got citizenship of USA. The petitioner vide application dated 14.09.2023 applied for reissuance of passport, however, the respondents are not processing the same.

Notice of motion, returnable for 16.02.2024.

Ms. Neha Sharma, Senior Panel Counsel for Union of India, who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice and waives service. She seeks time to get instructions.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that vide order dated 16.02.2024, the passport authority has rejected application of the petitioner and the said order is an appealable order.
3. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedy as permissible by law.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
