SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (Oral)

1. The learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana on instructions imparted to him submits that the verdicts of eviction passed in respect of the disputed lands against the judgment debtors concerned, and as become respectively enclosed in Annexures P-1 and P-2, thus have acquired binding and conclusive effect.
2. Therefore, he submits that both Annexures P-1 and P-2, were required to be promptly and successfully enforced.
3. However, he very fairly submits that though an execution petition became instituted before the learned Assistant Collector concerned, and though as unraveled by Annexure P-3, with echoings therein that the Assistant Collector concerned proceeded to appoint the BDPO concerned, as the executing officer, for thus ensuring the successful executions of Annexures P-1 and P-2, but he submits that despite Annexure P-3, becoming drawn on 07.12.2021, yet the said verdicts even upto now remain not completely and successfully enforced.
4. This Court appreciates the above fair and forthright

as made upon the respondent concerned, to ensure the promptest and successful execution of conclusive and binding verdicts of eviction, thus would beget the relevant activation.

5. In consequence, if as of now, no proceedings beyond 07.12.2021, have been initiated at the instance of the learned Assistant Collector concerned, thereupon, the latter is directed to forthwith initiate the requisite steps for ensuring that completest and successful execution, rather is made vis-a-vis Annexures P-1 and P-2.

6. In case there is resistance and obstruction meted to the executing officer concerned, thus for ensuring that possession of the panchayat lands, is restored to the Gram Panchayat concerned, thereupon, it is open to the executing officer concerned, to seek police help, and, on such police help being asked, from the Superintendent of the Police, of the District concerned, the latter shall forthwith render such police help, so that, thereby the resistance and obstruction to the fullest and completest execution of Annexures P-1 and P-2, rather becomes completely overcome.

7. The Executing Court or the Court of the learned Assistant Collector, First Grade is directed to within a period of one month from today, ensure that the completest and fullest execution, is made of Annexures P-1 and P-2, and is also directed to, in respect of the above record a subjective satisfaction, through an order being drawn in the said regard. Disposed of accordingly.
