1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 14.07.2023 passed in CM-10743-CWP-2023 in CWP-12577-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Uttam Singh, IAS, Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Karnal, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 14.07.2023 passed in CM-10743-CWP-2023 in CWP-12577-2023 has since been complied with and the competent authority has decided the appeal of the petitioner, by passing the speaking order dated 04.10.2023 (Annexure R-1).
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
