Counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are major and petitioner No.2 converted into Muslim religion and thereafter, performed *Nikah* with petitioner No.1 who belongs to Muslim religion; that the said marriage is performed by the petitioners against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7 who are related to petitioner No.1. The private respondents are extending threats to the petitioners to cause harm to their life and liberty and in this regard, the petitioners have filed representation (Annexure P-5) with respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action against the private respondents.

- 2. Notice of motion.
- 3. Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Superintendent of Police, Jind to consider representation dated 18.1.2024 (Annexure P-5) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
