The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.158 dated 14.06.2023 registered under Sections 15 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (offence under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, Sections 25(6), 25(7) of Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 307, 323, 186, 332, 353 IPC added later on) at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar (Rural).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 06.02.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
