KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuance of directions upon respondents no.1 and 2 to conclude the enquiry initiated upon a representation dated 01.10.2022 (Annexure P-7), now pending before respondent no.2, in case FIR No.65, dated 26.04.2022, under Sections 341, 342, 323, 506 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Shambu, District Patiala (Annexure P-1), in a time bound manner in the light of settlement dated 27.04.2022, (Annexure P-2), arrived at between the petitioner and respondent no.4.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by SI Bahadur Ram, that on account of the settlement (*supra*) arrived between the workers and the petitioners as well as the management of the company, the investigating officer concerned has prepared a

cancellation report which was duly approved by Station House Officer concerned, and now is pending approval of the Senior Superintendent of Police concerned.

3. He further submits that on getting appropriate approval from the Senior Superintendent of Police concerned, the cancellation report will be filed before the learned *Illaq*a Magistrate concerned within 15 days thereafter.

4. In view of the aforesaid statement, suffered by learned counsel for the petitioners, no further direction is required to be passed in the instant petition. Therefore, the instant petition is **disposed of** accordingly.
