1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 09.04.2002 (Annexure P-35) by which one month notice to terminate the services of the petitioner has been given and as interim relief, to stay the operation of order dated 09.04.2002 (Annexure P-35) with further direction to the respondent-Board to absorb the petitioner on regular basis in terms of policy Annexure P-17.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from the petitioner.

3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same, if any cause still survives.
