RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the judgment and decree dated 23.03.2013 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Sangrur.
2. Perusal of the case file shows that the decree qua which the contempt is alleged, was passed by the Civil Court. The said Court is having sufficient power and wide competence to get its own order/decreed executed. The petitioner can get the aforesaid decree executed or get her grievance remedied by availing an appropriate modality before the Court below.
3. In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any more.
4. Dismissed.



5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy before the court below, but in accordance with law.
6. Needless to say that if there is any limitation period provided for the remedy of the petitioner before the court below, then the time spent by her before this Court in the present petition, shall be excluded while calculating the period of limitation.
7. Pending application, if any, shall stand disposed of.
