1. On 23.01.2024, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Through the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer is made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.229 dated 30.12.2023, under Sections 323, 406, 420 and 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, Ludhiana Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

The allegations against the present petitioner are that the petitioner, who claimed himself to be the Vice President of Shiv Sena Samajwadi, has taken about ₹92,000/- from the complainant in order to provide bank loan to the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has a long acquaintance with the complainant and earlier also he has helped the complainant, by providing cash amounts to her. He further submits that the amount, which according to the complainant, was transferred in the account of the present petitioner is infact in lieu of the amount, which was earlier given by the petitioner to the complainant as a help.

Notice of motion for 9.4.2024.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Digvijay Nagpal, AAG, Punjab-accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall, however, join the investigation as and when called for and shall also abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.”

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by HC Jagjeevan Singh, submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation in pursuance to the aforesaid order, and he has fully co-operated with the investigation process, and is no more required for any further custodial investigation.

3. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed, and order dated 23.01.2024 is, hereby, made absolute, on the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
