SUMEET GOEL, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the impugned order dated 12.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by ld. JMIC, Hoshiarpur whereby petitioner was declared as proclaimed person in case FIR No.06 dated 08.07.2015, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 and 494 IPC, at Police Station NRI, District Hoshiarpur.
2. On 18.03.2024, the following order was passed:

“On request of learned counsel for the petitioner, hearing is deferred to 18.04.2024.

To be heard along with CRM-M-13614-2024.

Operation of the impugned order dated 12.03.2018 (Annexure P-2 passed by JMIC, Hoshiarpur) shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.”
3. Vide order of even date i.e. 18.04.2024 passed in CRM-M-13614-2024, the FIR in question stands quashed upon a settlement having been entered into between the parties in respect of which report has also been received from the concerned lower Court/Illaq Magistrate.

4. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case, it would be in the interest of justice that the impugned order dated 12.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) is quashed.
5. Ordered accordingly.
6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
