This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 19.10.2023 passed in CWP-23812-2023.

Perusal of the file shows that the order qua which the contempt is alleged is of the nature, for determination of contempt for which a lot of disputed questions would be required to be adjudicated upon. However, adjudication of disputed questions of fact would not even be appropriate in the contempt petition. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
