Present petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 28.12.2023 (Annexure P-6), in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of their grievance, the petitioners submitted a legal notice before respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Patiala, but the same is pending, as no action has been taken so far. It is further submitted that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to dispose of aforesaid legal notice dated 28.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Bajwa, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and he has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, present writ petition is disposed of and respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Patiala is directed to consider and dispose of the legal notice dated 28.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioners and to pass a reasoned/speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt or production of certified copy of this order.
