RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 25.07.2023 passed in CWP-15696-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Dusmanta Kumar Behera, Secretary, Development and Panchayats Department, Haryana, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 25.07.2023 passed in CWP-15696-2023 has been complied with and legal notice sent by the petitioners has been decided by passing a speaking order dated 29.02.2024 (Annexure P-1).
4. Counsel for the petitioners has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left un-addressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
