1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act and Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 20.12.2022 passed in CWP-2455-2018.
2. Counsel for the respondents has pointed out that vide order dated 05.02.2024 passed in LPA-367-2024, the Division Bench has ordered that no coercive action shall be taken against the respondents herein.
3. In view of the above, the present petition does not survive any more.
4. Dismissed.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to file a fresh petition, in case the above-said order dated 05.02.2024 is ever vacated or the decision in the aforesaid LPA goes in his favour.
