DEEPAK SIBAL, J.(ORAL)

(1) Two affidavits, both dated 21.02.2024, of Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) and Deputy Superintendent of Police, Raikot, have been filed by the State in the Court today, which are ordered to be taken on the record.

(2) As per affidavit filed by the DSP, Raikot, statement of proforma respondent-Ramandeep Kaur has been recorded by the police as per which she is presently residing with her aunt and has no threat perception from her parents. However, the appellant is untraceable.

(3) Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant still fears danger to his life and limb at the hands of the parents/relatives of proforma respondent-Ramandeep Kaur and therefore, had made himself scarce. However, he shall now appear before DSP, Raikot and apprise him

of the danger that he faces.

(4) In case the appellant presents himself before DSP, Raikot, the DSP is directed to consider the appellant's threat perception and then take appropriate steps as he deems fit to ensure that no bodily harm comes to the appellant.

(5) It is clarified that the afore direction by this Court shall not preclude the State from taking any action against the appellant in case he has violated any provision of law.

(6) Disposed of.

(7) All pending miscellaneous application(s) also stand disposed of.
