Prayer in the present appeal is for grant of anticipatory bail to the appellant in FIR No.102 dated 22.04.2023, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 379 and 506 of the IPC, 1860 and Section 3(2)(va) of SC/ST Act, 1989 (Section 325 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Cheeka, District Kaithal.

This Court vide order dated 23.01.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the appellant, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that in pursuance to the order dated 23.01.2024, the appellant has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from DSP Kuldeep Singh, does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the appellant is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 23.01.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present appeal is disposed of.
