1. The petitioner by way of this writ petition challenges his transfer from Roopnagar to Amristar.
2. Learned counsel submits that earlier the respondents had transferred the petitioner and the said order was challenged by him before this Court on the ground of competency and this Court passed an interim order staying the transfer which was ultimately withdrawn by the respondents and the writ petition was rendered infructuous. Now the respondents have again issued an order of transfer which has been impugned in this writ petition.
3. In the opinion of this Court, a person cannot be allowed to continue at a place for all times and it being a transferable post, the transfer order dated 11.01.2024, cannot be said to be illegally passed.
4. No case for interference is made out.
5. The writ petition is devoid of merit and is dismissed accordingly.
6. All pending misc. application(s) also stand disposed of.
