1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act and Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 01.05.2023 passed in CWP-33962-2019.

2. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 01.05.2023 passed in CWP-33962-2019 has been complied with and speaking order dated 21.02.2024 has been passed. Copy of the order dated 21.02.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondents in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.

3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
