The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the due amount of Rs.76,66,918/- qua the works of Up-gradation and maintenance of roads, executed by the petitioner, along with interest @ 12% per annum.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the work of Up-gradation and maintenance of Tarn Taran Jandiala to Bath Package No.PB-22-014 under PMGSY-III (Batch-II), E.E. Sanction No.413 dated 30.07.2021 and work of Up-gradation and maintenance of Khadoor Sahib to Tarn Taran Package No.PB-22-015 under PMGSY-III (Batch-II), E.E. Sanction No.406 dated 30.07.2021 were allotted to the petitioner vide different allotment letters and the payment of running bills has also been released to the petitioner, however the payment 4th and final bills has not been released even though the aforesaid works stand successfully executed.

He contends that in this regard, a representation dated 28.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) has been sent by the petitioner and that despite a lapse of about one month since the date of the representation neither any decision has been taken thereupon nor has the due and undisputed payment been released by the respondents. He further contends that he would be satisfied in case the respondent-authorities are directed to look into the representation and the grievance espoused by the petitioner therein and a speaking order is passed thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Saurav Verma, Addl. A.G. Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and the respondent No.5-the Executive Engineer, Construction Division No.1, PWD B & R Branch, Amritsar, is directed to take note of the representation dated 28.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) sent by the petitioner and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner being established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of three months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
