Status report by way of an affidavit of Shri Mahesh Kumar, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Mujesar, Faridabad along with custody certificate has been filed on behalf of respondent- State.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of 3rd petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.57 dated 27.01.2022 registered under Section 420 of the IPC, 1860 & Sections 4, 76 of Chit Fund Act, 1982 registered at Police Station NIT Faridabad, District Faridabad.

The earlier 1st petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 12.12.2022 and 2nd petition was dismissed on merits by this Court vide order dated 07.07.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that custody period of the petitioner is now more than 01 year and 10 months and so, petitioner be allowed bail.

After going through the previous order, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, at this stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has made a statement so as to withdraw this petition with a prayer to direct the Trial Court to expedite the trial.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn.

Trial Court is directed to make all possible endeavour to expedite the trial.
