This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents especially respondent Nos.2 to 5 to supply the information to the petitioner sought through application dated 25.08.2021 (Annexure P-1).
