1. On 31.07.2023, following order was passed:-

“This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the order dated 27.03.2017 (Annexure P-2) in case FIR No.0057 dated 18.05.2016 registered for offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City, Division No.2, District Pathankot.

The petitioner herein who stands declared as a proclaimed persons vide order dated 27.03.2017 impugnes the said order claiming that the petitioner after more than six years has now finally decided to appear before the Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Let the petitioner appear before the concerned court within a period of one week from today. In case, the

petitioner appears before the trial Court within a week from today, and files an application seeking admission on bail, this Court is quite sanguine that the same shall be adjudicated by the trial Court on the same day in accordance with law.

To come up on 18.09.2023. ”

2. Despite availing repeated opportunities, petitioner has opted not to appear before the trial Court.
3. In view of the above, this Court has left with no other option to dismiss the present petition.
5. Ordered accordingly.
6. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed off.
