The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to implement the judgment dated 14.09.2018 (Annexure P-3) passed by this Court in CWP-22185-2015, titled as Balbir Singh Versus Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. and others; and judgment dated 27.09.2010 (Annexure P-4) passed in CWP No.539 of 2009, partly upheld in LPA No.450 of 2011 vide judgment dated 12.03.2013 (Annexure P-5) among all of its employees as the above said judgments are the judgments in rem and the department is under legal obligation to implement it upon all the similar situated employees or on in alternate the respondent be directed to decide the representation dated 11.02.2019 (Annexure P-8) followed by representation dated 19.09.2019 (Annexure P-9).

2. After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars by challenging the seniority list.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
