The present letters patent appeal is directed against the order of the learned Single Judge passed in **CWP No.14202 of 2019** which was decided alongwith CWP No.798 of 2023 on 19.05.2023.

2. The State preferred LPA No.175 of 2024 in the case of Sohan Lal, the writ petitioner in CWP No.798 of 2023, without any success and the Coordinate Bench had dismissed the appeal on 19.01.2024.

3. Keeping in view the judgment passed in the connected case, there is no tangible reason as such to take a fresh look in the present letters patent appeal, which is also barred by 210 days. Mr. Verma on instructions from Mr. Baljinder Singh, ASI, Sangrur, has pointed out that the respondent has already been reinstated in pursuance of the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

4. Resultantly, the present appeal and the application for condonation of delay of 210 days in filing the appeal are dismissed.
