JASGURPREET SINGH PURI J.(Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing the impugned order dated 14.11.2018 (Annexure P-10).

2. At the outset learned counsel for the respondents No.2 to 4 stated that all the benefits alongwith interest @ 6% per annum (simple) has since been paid to the petitioner and therefore the present petition has become infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submitted that he may be granted liberty to file a representation with regard to the aforesaid limited prayer for grant of ACP to respondent No.2/competent authority within a period of two months from today and thereafter to decide the same by passing a speaking order.

4. On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondents No.2 to 4 submitted that he has no objection in case the petitioner files any representation with regard to the limited prayer as aforesaid.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances and limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is permitted to file a representation to respondent No.2 within a period of two months from today.
6. It is directed that in the event of the petitioner filing any such representation for grant of aforesaid limited prayer for ACP, then the respondent No.2/concerned authority shall consider and decide the same by passing a well-reasoned speaking order and in case, petitioner is found to be entitled, he shall be granted the benefit of ACP within a period of three months thereafter alongwith interest @ 6% per annum (simple).
7. Disposed of.
