Applicant has admittedly appended his signatures on compromise dated 12.08.2020. Plea raised, at this stage, is that applicant was under an impression that land bearing khasra No. 3967/1 (0-3) marlas is not a part of compromise and same would be allotted to respondent No. 5 as other co-sharers have already sold some part of the land adjoining thereto.

Learned counsel for applicant is unable to deny that compromise dated 12.08.2020 was duly signed by applicant. He is unable to point out any ground for recalling order dated 18.08.2020.

Review Application is, accordingly, dismissed.
