SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hisar for expeditious disposal of criminal case arising out of FIR No.91 dated 18.12.2016, under Sections 323, 34, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC registered at Women Police Station, Hisar, preferably, within time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the FIR was registered in the year 2016 and since 2016, the case has not been decided and witnesses have not been examined. He has also placed on record *zimni orders*. The first order dated 22.02.2017, which is placed on record as Annexure P-2, states that challan papers and accompanied documents are placed on file and *prima facie* case for commission of offence punishable under Section 498-A read with Section 34 IPC, 406 IPC read with Section 34 IPC, 323 read with Section 34 IPC and 506 IPC read with Section 34

IPC is made out against the accused and charges were framed and the case was adjourned to 17.04.2017.

3. Thus, a perusal of all the dates show that the trial is going on at a fair pace and it is only because of the fact that many adjournments and exemptions have been sought by the petitioner himself that there is delay in decision.

4. Learned State counsel contends that out of 8 witnesses, 5 witnesses have been examined, 1 witness has been given up and 2 witnesses remains to be examined. The next date before the trial Court for examination of witnesses is 26.04.2024.

5. A perusal of the *zimni* orders shows that learned Court below is making every effort to conclude the trial at the earliest, therefore, no ground is made out for issuance of direction to the trial Court. Hence, the present petition is hereby dismissed.

6. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
