1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari to set aside impugned order dated 21.09.1993 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Punjab and order dated 02.03.1987 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Commissioner, Patiala Division.

2. A perusal of order sheets would reveal that the instant matter has mostly been adjourning at the request of learned counsel for the petitioner; and on the last date of hearing, i.e. 10.07.2024, the following

order was passed by this Court:-

“ *Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks an accommodation to prepare and argue the matter.*
