On 24.01.2024, the following order was passed by this
Court:-

“By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.107 dated 07.11.2023, under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149 of IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the grievous injury is attributed to Satwinder Singh and not to any of the petitioner. Still further, it is submitted that the matter has been compromised amongst the parties. The copy of that compromise is Annexure P-2.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Anmol Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Mr. A.S. Kalra, Advocate has filed power of attorney on behalf of the complainant. Copy of paper book be supplied to them during the course of day.

Learned counsel for the complainant concedes the factum of the compromise.

Adjourned to 05.03.2024 for filing status report.

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In the meantime, petitioners are directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. They will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on interim bail on their furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. They shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

2. Today, on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioners have joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 24.01.2024 and are no longer required for further investigation.

3. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 24.01.2024, whereby the petitioners were granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, they shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
