Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that petitioner working as Ayurvedic Officer in Ayush Department being senior was given the DDO powers while working at Charkhi Dadri, Haryana, which powers have been withdrawn by the respondents while passing the impugned order dated 12.01.2024 (Annexure P-4). Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said powers have been withdrawn and given to a junior employee, which act is arbitrary and illegal.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the petitioner has any grievance with regard to the impugned order dated

12.01.2024 (Annexure P-4), he can file appropriate representation with the authorities concerned and in case, any such representation is filed, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of 15 days from the date of the receipt of the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file representation against the impugned order dated 12.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) before the authorities concerned.
