1. The petitioners are seeking issuance of directions to official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life, liberty and property as stipulated in Article 21 of the Constitution of India at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and their agents.

2. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners, who are senior citizens, are being unnecessarily harassed by the official respondents on account of their son's involvement in FIR No.49 dated 28.05.2023 registered at the instance of respondent No.4 and another FIR No.9 dated 29.05.2023 registered at the instance of one Sukhwinder Singh. Learned counsel submits that the son of the petitioners who is an accused in the abovementioned FIRs had been released on bail on 17.07.2023 and thereafter had been gone missing on 12.01.2024 and they too were not aware about his whereabouts. Learned counsel submits that the police officials have been repeatedly calling them to the police station concerned and subjecting them to harassment to find out about the whereabouts of their son whereas the

fact of the matter is that they themselves have no inkling about his whereabouts.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel submits that he would be satisfied if appropriate directions could be issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali to look into the representation dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate steps.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Luthra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

6. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali to look into the representation dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate steps, if any, required, in accordance with law.
